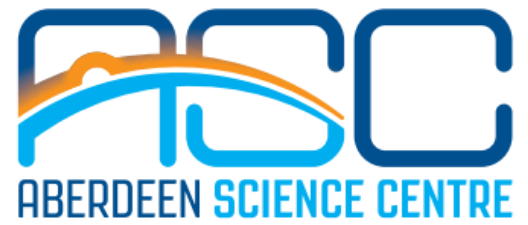


Teacher Guide

Duration: 30 mins

What to Expect

Pupils will talk about the difference between day and night by looking at pictures and objects which they will sort into groups. Through the use of props and audience interaction, pupils will learn about the movement of the Earth and why we get day and night.

- Differences between day and night
- Rotation of the Earth and why we get day and night
- Orbit of Earth around Sun and Seasonal Patterns
